Dear Prospective Student (and Parents/Guardians):

Welcome to Illinois Wesleyan University! We are thrilled that you are interested in our University and have chosen to spend a night on our campus. Our hope is that this visit will help you more clearly envision life as an Illinois Wesleyan Titan. During your stay, you will have the chance to talk with current students, spend time in the classroom, meet faculty, and get a general feel for campus life. We encourage you to take some time in advance to think about the questions you have and the things you would like to accomplish in order to have the most rewarding visit possible.

As a guest of the University, you are required to abide by the same rules and guidelines that govern the conduct of current Illinois Wesleyan students. Be aware that the following conditions apply:

- Your IWU student host will serve as a guide for you while you are on campus. Although we have done our best to match you with a student who has quality time to spend with you during your visit, please remember that academic work is your host's first priority and may require attention during your visit. Please respect his or her personal property and time, including time for sleep, study and classes. You are responsible for bringing your own personal items, including a sleeping bag, pillow, towel, etc.
- We encourage you to share activities that you would enjoy with your host and feel free to decline anything that may be uncomfortable for you.
- Participants in on-campus visitation programs are required to abide by applicable laws and the policies and regulations that govern student conduct at the University (see website: **Student Policies**). Please note that Illinois law prohibits the consumption of alcohol by persons under 21 years of age, as well as illegal drugs or controlled substances. Please do not ask your host to provide alcohol or take you to environments where alcohol is served.
- Please understand that any inappropriate or illegal behavior on your part during your campus visit will be considered by the Admissions Office, and may impact your status as an applicant or admittee to Illinois Wesleyan University.
